



FOLDED PINWHEEL PILLOW

Supplies Needed:

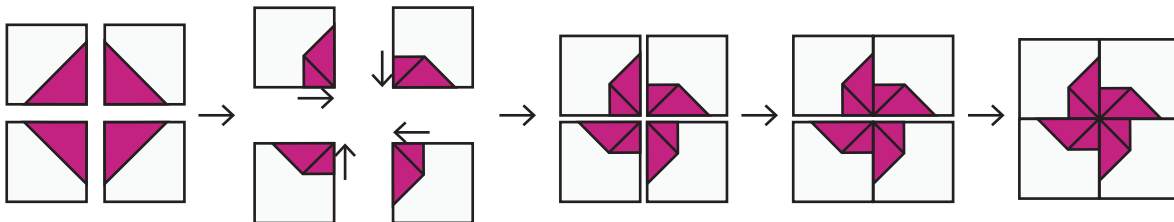
- (16) 5.5" squares background fabric
- (20) 4" squares pinwheel fabric
- 22" square backing fabric for quilting
- 22" square batting
- (2) 18" x 20.5" pillow back fabric
- 20" square pillow insert

Instructions:

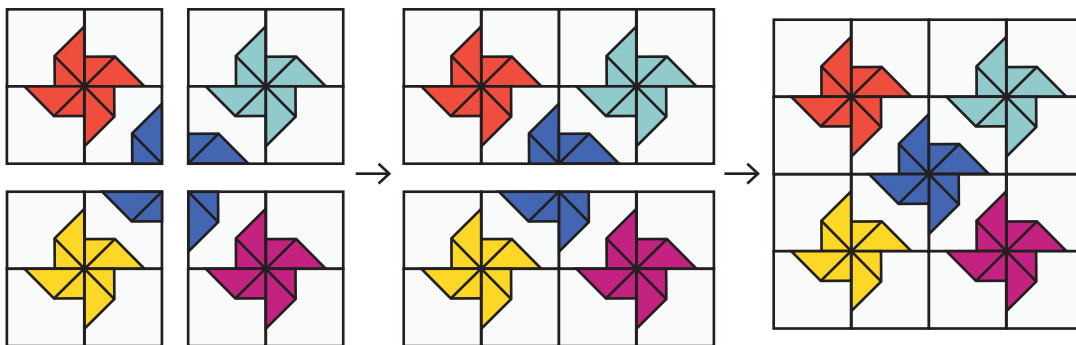
- For each pinwheel block, use
 - (4) 5.5" squares
 - (4) 4" squares.

Press 4" squares in half diagonally, then place in the corners of the 5.5" squares.

Fold the left corner of the 4" triangles toward the center. Baste folded triangles in place. Sew block together with a 1/4" seam by joining two squares, then sew those sections together. Make 4 pinwheel blocks.



- Add the squares for the 5th pinwheel to the center of the pillow and baste into place. Sew two blocks together, then join sections. Pillow top done!



- Layer pillow top, batting, and quilt backing. Quilt together by machine or by hand. Trim away excess batting and backing.

4. Use the 18" x 20.5" pieces to make the fold-over pillow backs. Hem each piece along one of the 20.5" edges by folding over 1.5", then folding over again 1.5". Topstitch the hem in place 1/8" from the bottom fold. Repeat with the other piece.

- Layer all pillow pieces with the pillow top right side up, the top foldover back with right side down, and the bottom foldover back with right side down. Line up the outside raw edges, pin in place and sew all the way around, backstitching over the folded edges of the back pieces.
- Turn inside out, stuff with 20" insert, and enjoy!
